1 Introduction

The paper must be written in English. It should be structured in the following way: introduction (problem statements, application area, research course), problem description, results, conclusion and references.

2 Information

Use A4 format and a single column layout. The paper is restricted to 2 – 6 pages. Please, do not number pages of document.

2.1 Titles and subtitles

Use `\section{}` and `\subsection{}` for titles and subtitles.

3 Floating environments

3.1 Figures

Before you use any figure, illustration or photograph, please ensure that you have obtained the relevant Copyright Permissions.

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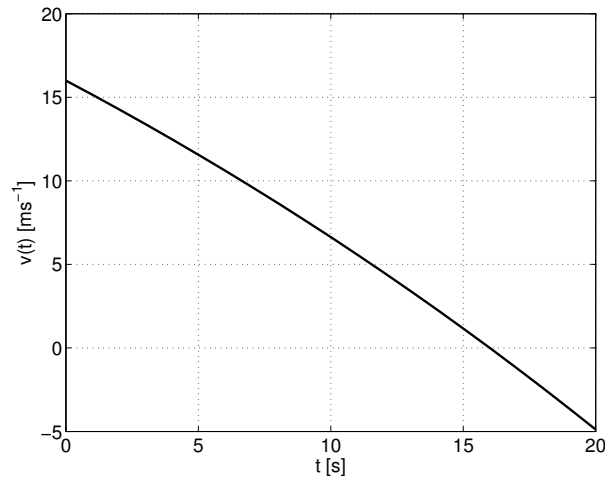


Figure 1: Title of the figure.

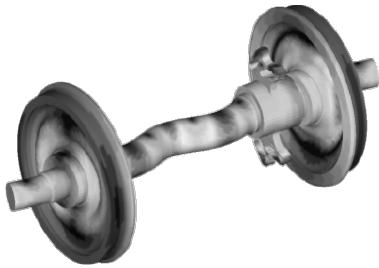


Figure 2: Wheelset modal analysis.

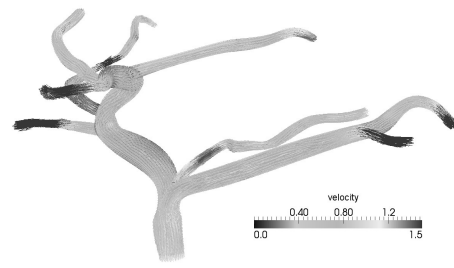


Figure 3: Flow in the hepatic portal vein.

Illustrations and pictures should be inserted using `\includegraphics[]{}{}` command. The captions of figures are created by the `\caption{}` or `\captionof{}{}` command and they are always centred, see Figures. 1, 2, 3.

In order to achieve the high quality of the proceedings, the resolution at least 300 dpi of bitmap pictures is recommended. In case there is a text in the figure, it is recommended to use similar font and font size as it is used throughout the paper

If you wish to insert more figures side by side use the standard *minipage* environment or commands from the *subfigure* package.

3.2 Tables

Use the standard *table* environment and the `\caption{}` command for floating tables or *center* environment and `\captionof{table}{}` for tables with fixed position. It is recommended to type headings of the table in italic text as shown in Table 1.

3.3 Equations

Equations should be centred and numbered consequently, starting from (1). For the single one-line equation use the *equation* environment.

For example, some theorem can be expressed as

$$h = -m \frac{1}{2k} \ln \left| \frac{2mg}{2mg - 2kv_0^2} \right|, \quad (1)$$

where g is a constant.

4 Referencing Convention

References should be generated using the *thebibliography* environment and referenced in the text by the `\cite{}` command. Note that references should be sorted in order of appearance.

The reference list at the end of this sample paper contains examples of the referencing of a journal paper, a conference paper, a book and other references the style of which should be followed in preparing your paper. Note that the references are generated in accordance with ISO 690; therefore authors can use online generator at <https://www.citace.com/>.
